

In Geography students will learn about the rainforests, volcanoes and earthquakes. Students will locate where the rainforests are, what animals live there, deforestation and how we can protect them.

Through our PE lessons we are going to be developing our skills of team work with the help of Doncaster Rovers. This will be through a range of sporting activities. We will also continue with swimming sessions

In art we are going to be looking at creating scrapbooks linked to animals in the rainforest.



This year, we are continuing with using a Thrive Approach in school. During out "Right time" sessions we will be looking at becoming a new class and developing our communication and tolerance skills. We've embraced thrive in our Setting

In Math's we will be looking at mass and capacity. They will be measuring weight in grams and kilograms and converting between the two. They will also measure capacity in milliliters and liters. They will also look at fractions and learn to add and subtract fractions with the same denominator.

In computing students will be learning how to use a laptop and understand the basics of Microsoft word and PowerPoint.



Science will be based around living things and their habitats. Students will be learning how to group animals into different categories and classify creatures between vertebrates and invertebrates.
