

FROZEN PLANET

This half term we will be focusing on the texts:
Shackleton's Journey and Pugs of the frozen North.

We will firstly be looking at how to make our writing descriptive and adventurous, making sure that we are using extended noun phrases and accurate punctuation

Then we will be creating a balanced argument where we will have to acknowledge both sides of an argument and present them fairly.



In Math's we will be looking at fractions and all the different things that we can do with them.

We will be ordering them, comparing them, finding fractions of shapes and numbers and some of us may even start adding, subtracting and multiplying them!

Science will be based around the topic of "living things and adaptations". We will be focusing on animals and learning how to classify them using a range of different features. We will then focus on animals who inhabit the Antarctic region and how climate change is impacting how they adapt to their surroundings.

This year, we are going to begin with using a Thrive Approach in school. During our "Right time" sessions we will be looking at becoming a new class and developing our communication and tolerance skills. This will be supported by Miss Holmes

Through our PE lessons we are going to be developing our skills of team work through a variety of different games and challenges.

In PSHE and SEAL time, we will discuss our mental health and how we can keep our minds as healthy as our bodies.

We will be verbalising issues that affect mental health both positively and negatively

In art we are going to be looking at the art used within the Inuit tribes. We will design our own printing block and experiment with creating a design.

In Geography we will be focusing on the Polar biomes. We will be researching their climates and how they experience night and day. Then we will move to investigate the polar oceans and landscapes and how the change in our climate is affecting them and the animals, people and cultures that live there.
