If you have any questions about SEND, please speak to Emma Place.



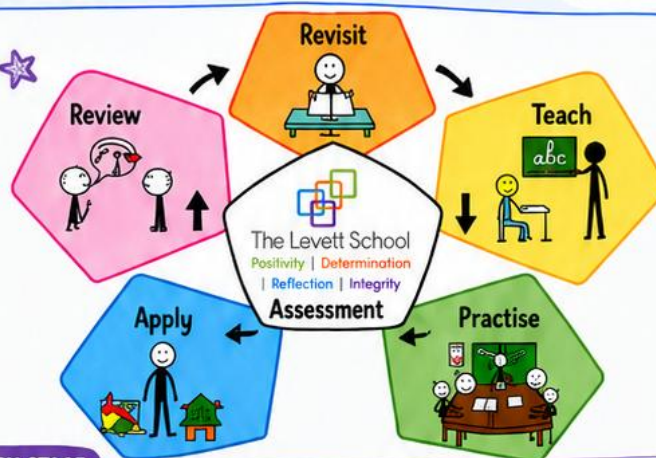

Assessment sits at the centre and helps us decide next steps.

COGNITION & LEARNING

We break tasks down, provide scaffolds and adapt resources to reduce barriers.

SENSORY & PHYSICAL

We provide movement breaks, adaptive equipment and flexible environments.

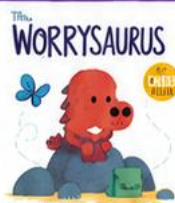

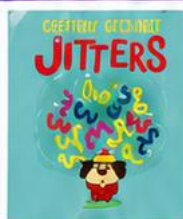

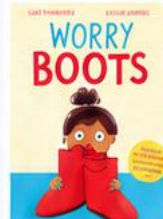
