TERMLY TEA

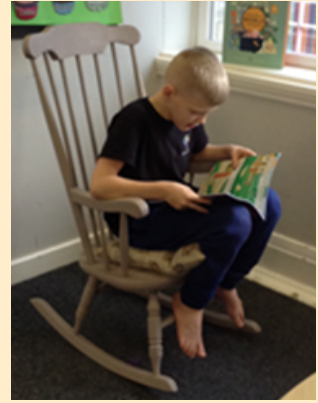
It was lovely to have so many Parents and Carers attend our 'Termly Tea' event and take time to celebrate pupils learning and achievements on their journey!
