Our Commitment to SEN Support

At The Levett School, we believe that every child deserves the best possible learning experience. We are dedicated to meeting the diverse needs of our students through personalised support, tailored resources and a supportive school community. Our SEN provision includes a range of strategies and interventions to ensure that all our students receive the help they need to succeed.

Key Features of Our SEN Provision

SEND Plans: Each student with SEN is supported by a tailored plan that outlines specific goals and the strategies we will use to help them achieve their potential. These plans are reviewed regularly to ensure ongoing progress. We also support EHCP outcomes through shorter term, adapted targets.

Text led Intervention: Mrs Goddard is our Literacy Lead in School and takes care of our library space. Each week Mrs Goddard provides a multi sensory approach to 'text led learning' with each class.

Pastoral Support: In addition to one-to-one support is available to encourage social interaction, build academic skills, and support emotional and behavioural development across classes. Hot spots are identified on a weekly basis and additional support are intervention are targeted to provide better outcomes in these areas.

Flexible Learning Environment: Recognising that each student learns differently, we have adapted learning spaces that cater to sensory needs, provide cosy corners (quiet areas for reflection) as well as the offer of spaces to provide support for regular movement breaks.

New Initiatives for SEN Support

Here are some exciting new initiatives that we're rolling out this term:

Sensory Room: We've recently introduced a new sensory room designed to support students with sensory processing difficulties. The room is equipped with calming lights, sensory toys and relaxing sounds to help students regulate and return to their lessons feeling refreshed and focused.

Peer Mentoring Program: To further support our students with social and emotional needs, we've launched a peer mentoring program. Selected students are trained to mentor younger pupils or those who need additional social support, helping them build stronger peer relationships.

We have just trialed our new 'Parent Open Day', this is where we invite Parents/Carers, Mainstreams and Pupils in to school to celebrate the successes of the term.
